

## **Editorial policy of the journal**

### **«Bulletin of the Samara State Economic University»**

1. The purpose of the journal is to support the development of economic science through the dissemination of the best Russian and foreign practices, the presentation of new theoretical and practical materials in the field of regional and sectoral economics, management, state and municipal administration, economic theory, finance and the world economy, as well as the creation of an open information platforms for discussing the results of scientific research and understanding modern economic processes and trends.

2. The journal tasks include:

- generalization of scientific and practical achievements in the field of regional and sectoral economy, management, state and municipal administration, economic theory, finance and the world economy;

- attracting the attention of scientists and specialists from various scientific schools to the most relevant and promising areas of scientific research on the topics of the journal, which gives the journal the necessary discussion and constructiveness;

- attraction to scientific cooperation and exchange of opinions of researchers from different regions and states;

- publication of scientific articles reflecting the results of original open research works, theoretical and experimental studies in Russian and English;

- providing conditions for the publication of original scientific articles by a wide range of Russian and foreign researchers, practitioners, representatives of the regions, undergraduates, master and graduate students, doctoral students.

3. The editorial policy is based on the following principles:

- compliance of the published materials with the scientific orientation of the Bulletin of the Samara State University of Economics;

- strict quality control of published materials;

- objective and independent assessment of the submitted materials.

4. As quality criteria, the editors use:

- relevance of the topic;

- scientific novelty and practical significance of the presented research results;

- conscientiousness of the research, originality and reliability of the submitted materials;

- use of advanced research methods;

- accuracy, completeness and clarity of the presentation of the material.

5. Articles are accepted for publication if these works belong to:

- scientific and pedagogical workers (hereinafter referred to as SPW), practitioners and independent researchers;

- graduate students;

- students of master's programs (in collaboration with the SPW);

- students of bachelor's and specialist's degree programs (in collaboration with the SPW);

- students of bachelor's and specialist's programs of any courses, if the article is prepared in the framework of research works/projects and scientific grants (in co-authorship with the SPW).

6. At least 8 articles are placed in one issue of the journal.

7. The maximum number of authors in one article should not exceed 4 people.

8. A maximum of 3 (three) internal articles are allowed in one issue of the journal. An article is recognized as internal if it contains at least one author who has an affiliation with SSEU.

9. No more than 30% of internal articles may be published in one issue of the journal. An article is recognized as internal if it contains at least one author who has an affiliation with SSEU.

10. The independence of the assessment is ensured by the technology adopted in the editorial office, which includes the following elements:

- the decision on the possibility of publication, or the need for revision, or the rejection of the submitted materials is made by a reviewer competent in the subject matter of the materials being reviewed;

- articles approved by the reviewer and having an expert opinion on the possibility of open publication are allowed for publication;

- the final decision on the publication of the article is made by the editor-in-chief on the basis of a positive review and the availability of an expert opinion;

- verification of materials for originality is carried out through the «Anti-plagiarism» system. Articles with originality of 80% (no more than 10% of borrowings) are accepted for publication;

- the authors are warned about the responsibility for the conscientiousness of the described research results, for the reliability and legality of the factual materials cited in the articles.

11. There is no fee for publishing articles.

12. The target audience of the journal includes researchers, scientists, teachers, students and practitioners.
