

FORMATION OF MANAGEMENT DECISIONS LOGISTICS SUPPLY

Keywords: supply management, procurement, logistics, supply, trends in supply chain management, logistics system, decomposition of the logistics system, the cycle of procurement, supply strategies.

The paper discusses current issues in managing supply logistics principles, the basic goals and tasks in the sphere of decision making in the logistics supply, the necessity of decomposing the logistics system to develop a strategy for managing the logistics supply chain.

Among the major trends in supply chain management, according to D.I. Tokarev, those trends can be distinguished that are related to supply chain management and integration of logistics and strategic management [5]:

1. Tendency to use a single supplier, expanding partnerships between the provider and consumer information exchange.
2. Establishing long-term contracts.
3. The concentration of manufacturers efforts aimed at finished products in the design and assembly, which means reducing the procurement of raw materials, increasing the flow of components from suppliers, increasing share of the cost of supply in production costs.

4. Separation of the functions of procurement and logistics in strategy and operations (tactics).

5. Supply chain management.

6. Reducing cycle time. The overall development cycle and manufacturing cycle time seriously affect the supply. Supply department by working closely with a limited number of suppliers will be able to reduce the overall cycle time by 50-60%.

7. Integration into a business strategy. Objectives and strategies of the supply department integrated with corporate goals and strategies.

8. Logistics outsourcing.
